

Effusia Business Messenger v4.4 Migration Guide



Upgrading the Effusia Business Messenger system to version 4.4 from previous versions consists of 2 steps.

1. Upgrade your Effusia Server
2. Upgrade Effusia Consoles

Please ensure that you upgrade the applications in that order. All versions of the Effusia Console will work with Effusia Server 4.4 and we recommend that the Effusia Console 4.4 be used with Effusia Server 4.4.

Effusia Server Migration

The following steps allow an installation of Effusia Server 4.4 to retain all settings from an installation of all previous versions of the Effusia Server.

Step 1: Backup Important Server Files

1. Use Windows Explorer to locate the Effusia Server installation directory (usually `c:\Program Files\Effusia Server`)
2. Create a directory outside of the Effusia Server installation directory. This will temporarily hold the backed up server files
3. Copy `license.lic` (may be called simply `license` on some systems), the `logs` directory, the `offlinemessages` directory, and `UserStorage.jar` to the already created backup directory (**Note:** Backing up your important server files is no longer a required step as in previous upgrades; however, we still recommend backing up these important files.)

Step 2: Install Effusia Server 4.4

1. Run `setup.exe` and click Next
2. On the `Choose Application` screen, select Effusia Server and click Next
3. On the `Choose Install Location` screen, select the directory the Effusia Server is currently installed to (usually `c:\Program Files\Effusia Server`) and click Finish
4. Follow on-screen installation instructions
5. Your server will be restarted automatically

Effusia Console Migration

The Effusia Console can now be updated using the Console Update feature built into the server and consoles. To enable this update, follow these steps:

1. Open the Effusia Admin Tool
2. Go to Administration -> Console Updates
3. Click 'Browse' and locate the update zip file provided to you by Liquid Communication Systems. If you do not have an update zip file, please contact support@effusia.com for the update file.
4. Click 'Add'
5. Click 'Set Current' on the latest version of the console. Effusia Consoles will be required to download and install the update the next time the user logs in.

Effusia Admin Tool Migration

Starting with version 4.0, the Effusia Admin Tool functionality has been integrated into the Effusia Server. We recommend uninstalling the old Effusia Admin Tool application because it is no longer needed.

Administrators can access the new Admin Tool by opening a web browser and going to <https://<server>:8082/> where <server> is replaced with the IP address of your server. If you are on the same computer as the server you can go to <https://127.0.0.1:8082/>.

Note: You may see up to 2 security-related dialogs. Click OK or Yes on these dialogs to gain entry to the application. For more information on these dialogs, refer to the Effusia Server User's Guide.
